

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

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SOME PARTS ARE NEITHER PREFIX NOR SUFFIX

MOD – spasmodic, modernize, commode

GOL – golly, hypergolic, Mongolian

DACT – didactic, redacted, dactyl

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SOME PARTS ARE NEITHER PREFIX NOR SUFFIX

TAL – capital, tally, crystal, talent

TANT – distant, instant, tantalize, blatant

STEAD – instead, steadfast, homestead

BOL – symbol, bolster, embolus, diabolic

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WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF...

We enter **MOD, GOL, DACT, TAL, STEAD** and **BOL** into our dictionaries as word pieces?

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ENTERING WORD PIECES RESULTS IN...

Better translation!

How do I know? I've been doing it this way for over 20 years.

Over 200 reporters in the last 2 years can attest that it works.



LEARNING TO EDIT EFFECTIVELY

This may be a 180° from how you edit now.
 It will *increase* productivity.
 It is *guaranteed* to improve your translation rate.
 It will save you *oodles* of time.

1. **Search** for untranslates
2. **Ask** yourself "What is this supposed to be? Can it be anything else?"
3. **Define** the **SINGLE** untrans by itself
4. **Add** with surrounding outlines if needed


**DO NOT DEFINE AS PREFIXES OR SUFFIXES!
DEFINE JUST AS WORDS**

There are many word parts that will be entered as stand-alones

Not defined as a prefix

Not defined as a suffix

Contrary to what you may have been taught, this is OKAY!
