


This may be a 180° from how you edit now. It will *increase* productivity. It is *guaranteed* to improve your translation rate. It will save you *oodles* of time.

- 2. Ask yourself "What is this supposed to be? Can it be anything else?"
- 3. Define the SINGLE untrans by itself
- 4. Add with surrounding outlines if needed

DO NOT DEFINE AS PREFIXES OR SUFFIXES! DEFINE JUST AS WORDS

There are many word parts that will be entered as



WATCH YOUR REALTIME!!

Doing realtime without watching your screen is like trying to read in the dark. If you SEE errors then you won't continue writing the same mistake over and over and over.

The exception is speedbuilding. Don't watch your screen!


