

What is Captioning?

- Words on a picture
- Offline – done post-production
- Realtime – not verbatim but very close!
- Done remotely

- Words on a blank screen
- Live for educational and professional clients
- Realtime – not verbatim but very close!
- Remote or on-site

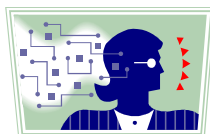

The Bare Necessities

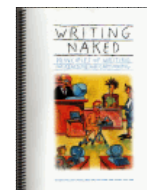
- SPEED, SPEED, SPEED!

Total Accuracy Rate




- Open your .rtf file in WORD
- Click on the Review Tab
- Click on "Word Count"
- Subtract # of errors from Word Count
- Divide total by Word Count
 - 2000 Word Count
 - 25 Total Errors

$1975 \div 2000 = 98.75\% = \text{TAR}$

- 98.5% is entry-level, on-air quality. Goal is above 99%.

- Redefine all profanity* – puck, ship, who are
- Dictionary building – names, current events, etc.





Prepare to Think Like a Captioner

- Prep in ADVANCE. Afterwards, it's too late!
- Willing to work unconventional hours such as late nights or early mornings, holidays, weekends, etc.
- 100% dedication to staying current

Prepare with Training

- Invest in captioning training – plan on at least six months and about \$1,000.
- A+ captioners didn't train themselves
- EduCaption – captioning companies call us for captioners!
- Certifications

Independent vs. Employee

- I.C. – flexible schedule, responsible for own equipment, freedom to work for multiple companies, responsible for invoicing
- Employee – set schedule known a week to a month in advance, may have equipment and software provided, work for one company, no need to invoice

Prepare for your first show



- Receive show assignment
- PREPARE from station web site, rosters, previous transcripts, etc.
- Write and enter all vocabulary into a job dictionary or main dictionary

Prepare for your first show

- Start a realtime file, connect to encoder and audio line
- Caption your show
- Read the file thoroughly, adding dictionary entries
- Send .txt file of show to your employer

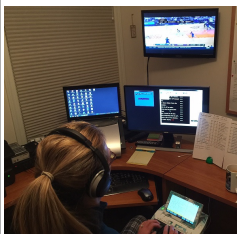
