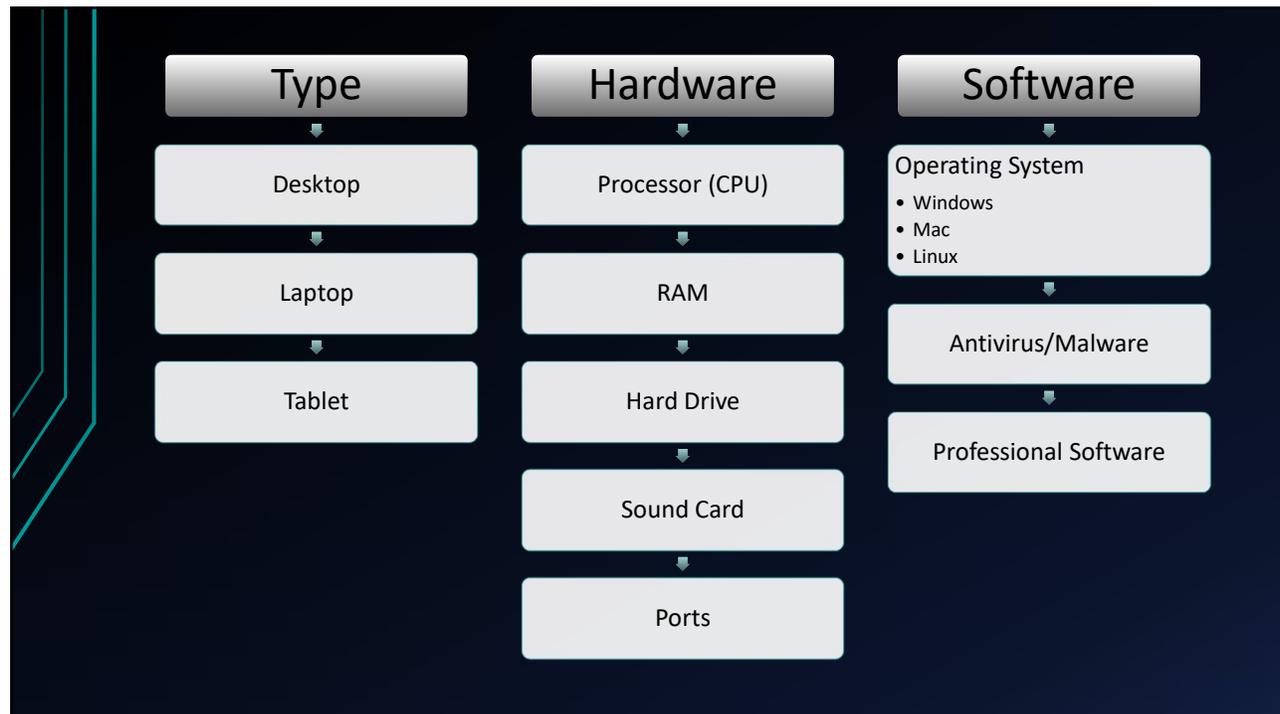
WHERE TO START?

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## WINDOWS 10 OR WINDOWS 11

- It's completely your choice; however, most computers available on the market today are Windows 11.
- If you currently have Windows 10 and your computer offers to upgrade to Windows 11 for you, again, that is your choice. I have chosen not to update to Windows 11 at this time from my current Windows 10 computer.
- If you are on anything below Windows 10, you **MUST** upgrade for security reasons! Windows 8, Windows 7, etc. are **not** supported by Microsoft and your computer and data is at risk!

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## Things to consider with computer types



**Desktops**

- Stationary
- Least expensive versus laptops
- Longer lifetime



**Laptops**

- Portable
- Ability to dock/make into desktop workstation
- Numerous options of brands, sizes, etc.



**Tablets**

- Extremely portable
- Inexpensive to very expensive
- Simplistic builds



**Chromebooks**

- Very inexpensive
- Great for web-based processing
- Not compatible with steno software

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## HARDWARE

*These are the bare minimum requirements.*

*The faster the processor, the better. The more RAM, the better. The bigger the hard drive, the better.*

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## HARD DRIVE VERSUS SOLID STATE DRIVE

A traditional hard drive uses a spinning magnetic disk to store data and can store a lot of data relatively inexpensively; however, they are slow because in order to access data, the hard drive must spin to the right location.

### SSDs (solid state drives)

- have no moving parts, and all data can be accessed equally easily.
- are way faster and use less power.
- make virtually no noise at all since they are non-mechanical.

A SSD-equipped PC will boot in less than a minute, and often in seconds.

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## Standard selections and choices right out of the box

- Name your computer (be sensible!)
- Proceed through step-by-step setup to connect to the internet, log in to your Microsoft account
  - Having a Microsoft account is extremely beneficial when setting up a new computer. If used on your current/old computer, it can bring in your favorites, passwords, etc., from Edge browser
- What **NOT** to do
  - Do not ignore the 'small print' on the step-by-step screens
    - The small print often includes such things as installing unnecessary software and programs and also allowing Microsoft to set up your computer for you based on their settings and predetermined needs

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## Set up your computer security settings

For most court reporters and captioners, the built-in Windows Security from Microsoft is sufficient for antivirus and malware protection

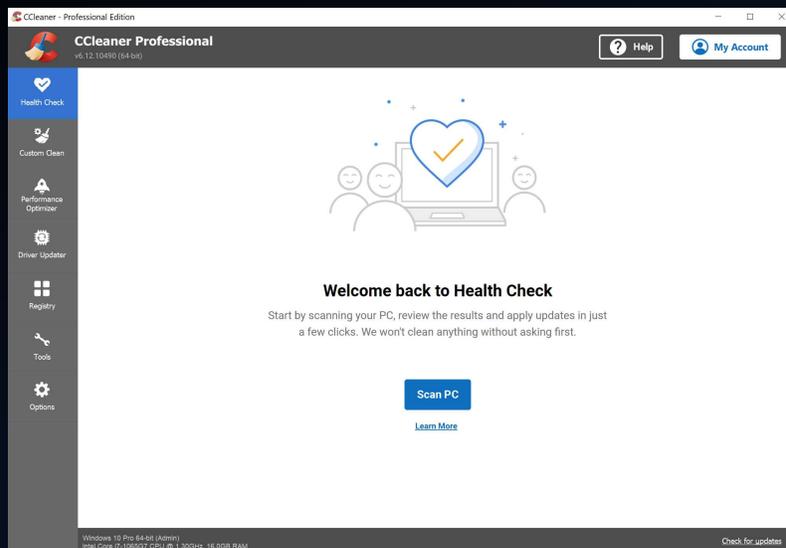
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## FINDING AND SETTING UP BITLOCKER

If you chose to go with a Pro version of Windows, BitLocker is automatically installed and ready to activate.

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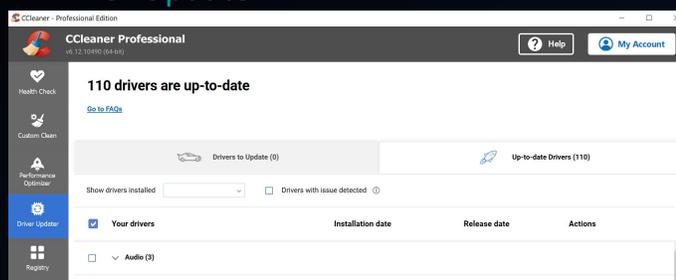

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## Cloud-based storage options

- **Dropbox**
  - *Offers cloud storage, file synchronization, personal cloud, and client software, accessible from any device or computer*
- **Microsoft OneDrive**
  - *File hosting service that allows users to sync files, photos, share/work together, and accessible from any device or computer*
- **Google Drive**
  - *File storage and synchronization service allowing file sharing and editing of documents with collaborators.*
- **Amazon Drive\*\***
  - *Cloud storage application offering secure cloud storage, file backup, file sharing, and photo printing*

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## Cloud-based storage costs

- Dropbox
  - *as low as \$9.99 per month*
  - *(billed annually)*
  
- Microsoft OneDrive
  - *as low as \$8.25 per month*
  - *(billed annually)*
  
- Google Drive
  - *as low as \$9.99 per month*
  - *(billed annually)*

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## Cloud-based storage: Sarah's primary pick

**Microsoft 365 Family**  
\$99.99/year

- For one to six people to share.
- Each person can use on up to five devices simultaneously.
- Works on PC, Mac, iPhone, iPad, and Android phones and tablets.
- Up to 6 TB of cloud storage (1 TB per person).
- Additional features in the Family Safety mobile app.

- Microsoft OneDrive
  - *Included with purchase of Microsoft 365 Family*
  - *Up to 6 TB storage (1 TB per user account) – included*
  - *Ongoing access to all Microsoft products online or downloaded (Word, PowerPoint, Excel, etc.)*
  - *Federal government approved products*
  - *HIPAA compliant*

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## What do others say?

I back up reporting stuff via Stenograph's Cloud Edge. At the end of every job before I leave, I back up to Dropbox. I also send work units to Dropbox on every job.

I back up work to multiple sources: Google Drive, Dropbox, and an external hard drive. Photos go to Google Photos and Shutterfly.

I use Carbonite and it backs up every morning at 3:30 a.m. automatically. I also do periodically back up on an external hard drive, but that is for work that is already completed, scanned copies of worksheets, and other records.

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## What do others say?

I back up all of my photos to a separate, small-in-size, portable hard drive.

When I'm working at home, my laptop is hooked up to a hub that has an external hard drive attached.

I back up everything on several jump drives, as well as my external hard drive.

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## TIPS AND WARNINGS WITH ANY BACKUP SERVICE

- Don't rely on one backup service alone (*cloud-based or physical*)
  - *Jump drives and external hard drives are best used for temporary backups and to transfer data*
- Duplication of backups is okay!
- Save backups with a "date" in the file name
  - *OHND entire year 2019 files 5-1-2023*

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## Keeping your computer secure

- **Tips**
  - Encrypt any drives that you have in your computer
    - Use “BitLocker To Go” for any flash drives that contain sensitive data
  - Store the recovery keys in multiple places. You can select more than one option during setup. Print and place in a fireproof box in your home or office.
  - **Keep track of your passwords!** If you forget your password AND lose your recovery key, you lose all of your data
  - Be cautious searching on the internet, reviewing emails, and more!
- **Security is a state of mind**

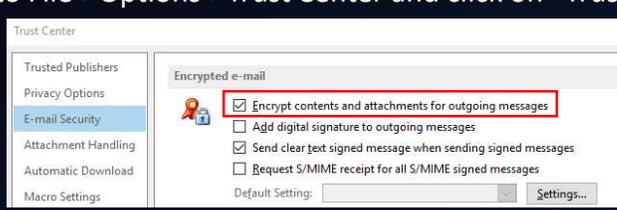

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## Secure Email - Encryption

- **Encrypting Email - Gmail**
  - Use the “Secure Mail for Gmail” Chrome extension to send encrypted messages
    - Recipient will need to know the password that you have decided for the email
    - Always make sure that you are viewing email with an https connection
- **Encrypting Email – Outlook for Desktop**
  - Navigate to File->Options->Trust Center and click on “Trust Center Settings”

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## Secure Email Identifying Phishing attacks

- Don't trust the display name

To: You <you@yourdomain.com>  
From: My Bank <accounts@secure.com>   
Subject: Unauthorized login attempt

- Look but don't click – Always check links
- Check for spelling mistakes
- Don't give up personal information
- Watch for urgent language in the subject line – “Your account has been suspended”
- Don't open any attachments you weren't expecting to receive
- If you receive a suspect email from a contact, verify that they meant to send it to you
- Flag known phishing attempt emails as spam (Gmail lets you flag as phishing)
